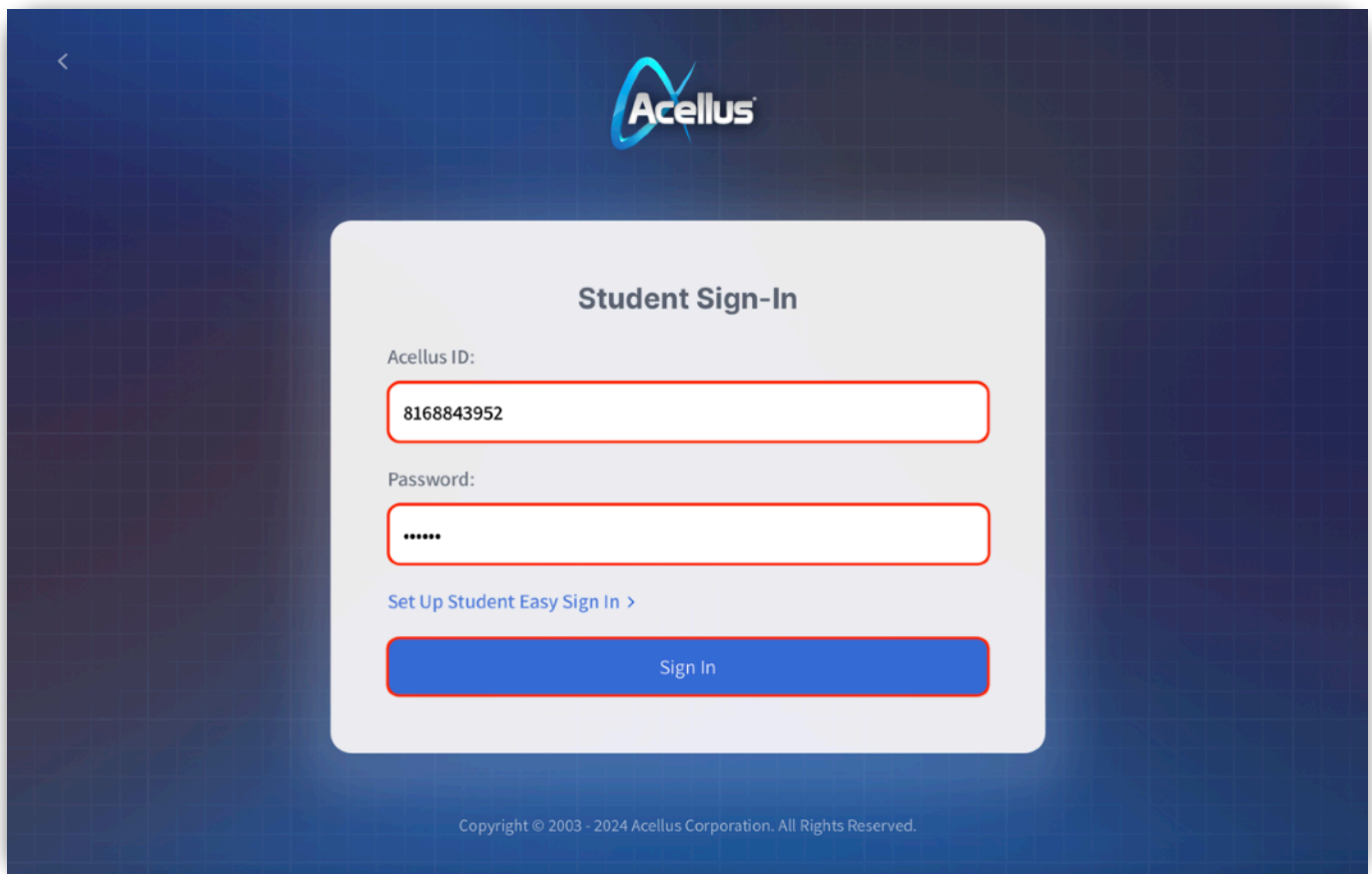


ACELLUS TUTORIAL

Student Sign-In

This tutorial will cover how to sign in as a student and how to set up the easy sign-in feature, which is a way for students to create their own custom sign-in credentials.

Students will need to download and install the [Acellus app](#) to sign in. This app is free and is available across all major operating systems, including ChromeOS, Windows, macOS, Android, iOS, and iPadOS. Once installed, students will be prompted to input their **Acellus ID** and **Password** and finish by clicking **‘Sign In’**.



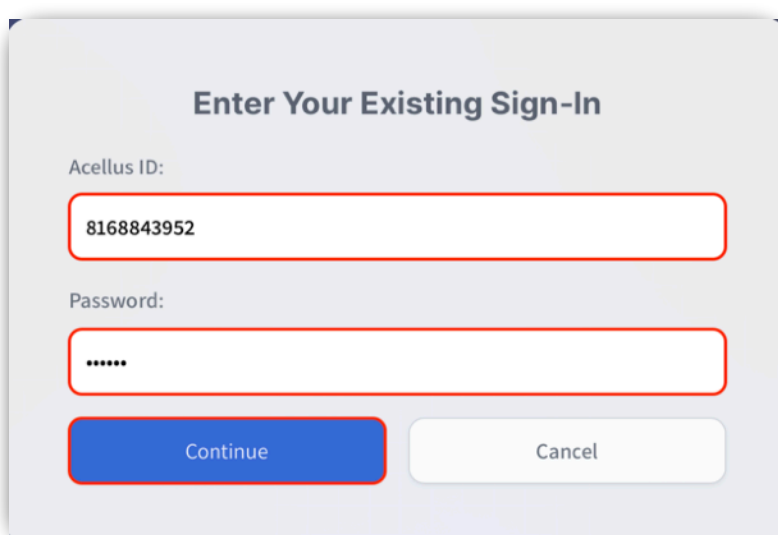
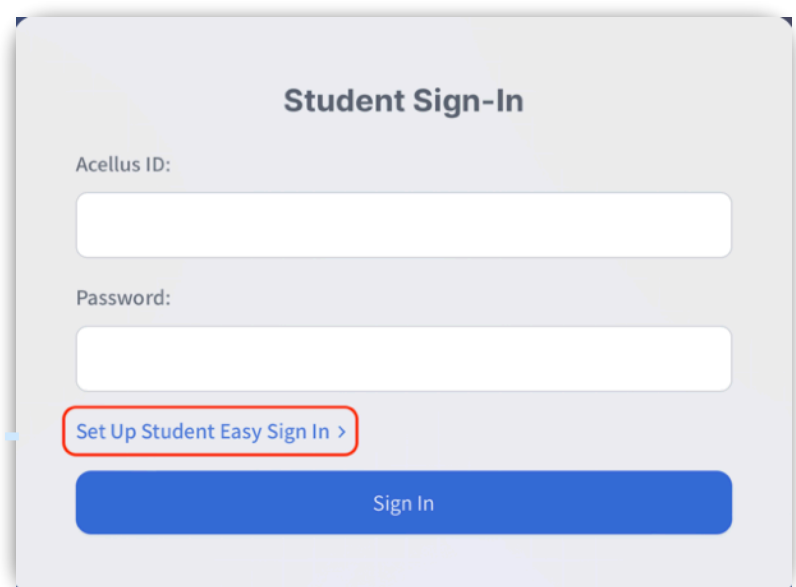
Note: The Acellus App includes integrated security features designed to protect the integrity of student work.

Student Easy Sign In

Students also have the option to log into Acellus using a username and password they come up with.

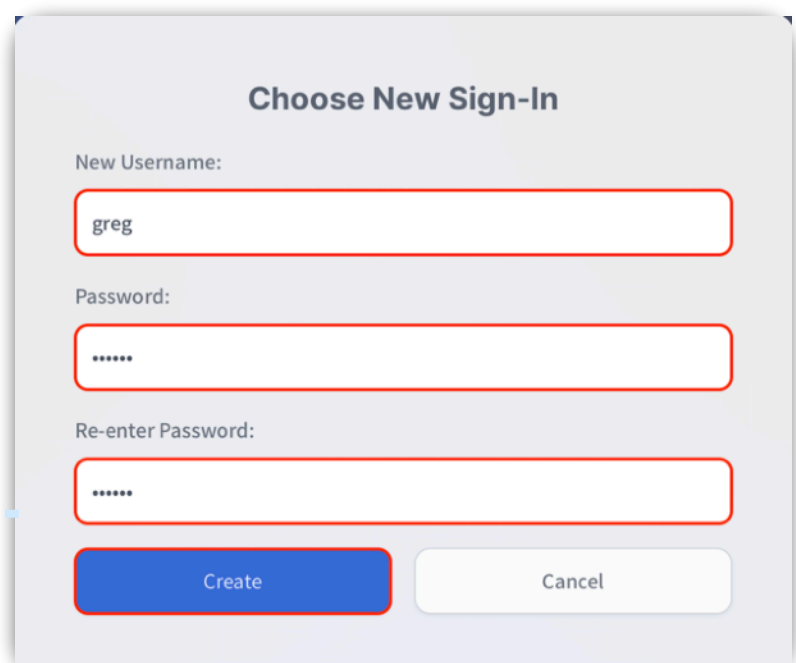
Note: While this feature allows students to sign into Acellus with the credentials they specify, they can only use their custom login information at the specific location where they originally added them to their account.

The first step in utilizing this feature is to click on **‘Set Up Student Easy Sign In’**, located below the Acellus ID and password fields on the student sign in screen.



Students will need to enter their default Acellus ID and password and then click **‘Continue’**.

The student can then choose a new username and password for their account. The login information will be applied after they click the **‘Create’** button.



Once the **“Easy Sign In”** has been created, the student will be able to log into Acellus using their new sign in username and password or by logging in with their Acellus ID and password.
